

Annual Notification

The local education agency is responsible for ensuring that workers and building occupants, or their legal guardians, are informed at least once each school year about inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities, including periodic surveillance activities that are planned or in progress.

Example of annual notification for schools with asbestos-containing materials:

Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Building Occupants,

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requiring schools to inspect and identify any asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM). Denver Academy hired a certified building inspector to identify and sample any suspect asbestos-containing building materials.

The law further requires the school to have an asbestos management plan. Denver Academy has an asbestos management plan available for review in the school district administrative office or the administrative office of the school during regular business hours. Kelley Lyons is our designated asbestos program coordinator, and all inquiries regarding the asbestos plan and asbestos-related issues should be directed to Kelley Lyons at 719-227-8836.

Updates for the year:

Last April, ACBM was removed from several classrooms in the main building in accordance with state and federal regulations. The school maintenance staff inspected the condition of the materials every six months and the condition of the material remains in good condition. Next year, we will hire a certified building inspector to re-inspect the ACBM for our required three year re-inspection.
